CLASS DESCRIPTIONS: all classes are open to horses or ponies, ridden by adults or juniors.

CLASS 1: BEGINNER HUNTER UNDER SADDLE – Walk-Trot

Open to all horses/ponies with limited horse show experience. To be shown at a walk and trot.

CLASS 2: BEGINNER HUNTER UNDER SADDLE – Walk-Trot-Canter

Same entry criteria as Class 1. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter.

CLASS 3: BEGINNER HUNTER Over Cross Rails

Same entry criteria as Class 1. To be shown over 6 cross-rail jumps at approximately 18”

CLASS 4: BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE – Walk-Trot

Open to all riders with limited horse show experience. To be shown at a walk and trot.

CLASS 5: BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION UNDER SADDLE – Walk-Trot-Canter

Same entry criteria as Class 4. To be shown at a walk, trot and canter.

CLASS 6: BEGINNER RIDER EQUITATION Over Cross Rails

Same entry criteria as Class 4. To be shown over 6 cross-rail jumps at approximately 18”

CLASS 7: LEAD LINE - Open to children 10 years and under, shown at the walk.

CLASS 8: LEAD LINE - Open to children 10 years and under, shown at the walk and trot.

CLASS 9: LOW HUNTER DERBY WARM UP OVER FENCES

To be shown over a course of approximately 8 fences not to exceed 2’3”.

CLASS 10: \$1000 LOW HUNTER DERBY

Horses/ponies will compete on a classic course of no less than 12 fences. Course height is 2’ with options set at 2’3”. Proper show attire required - Shadbelly encouraged. See judging criteria.

CLASS 11: FOX HUNTER OVER FENCES - To be shown over a course of approximately 8 fences not to exceed 2’6”. Open to Hunt members. Judged on performance and style suitable for the hunt field.

CLASS 12: LADIES’ HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

Open to lady riders only. To be shown at walk, trot, canter. Judge may request a hand gallop.

CLASS 13: GENTLEMAN’S HUNTER UNDER SADDLE

Open to gentleman riders only. To be shown at walk, trot, canter. Judge may request a hand gallop.

CLASS 14: HUNT TEAMS - Open to 2 or 3 team members. Shown over no less than 7 fences, at safe hunting distance, not to exceed 2’6”. Last obstacle may be jumped abreast.

Class 15: MEDIUM HUNTER DERBY WARM UP O/F Open to all horses & ponies. To be shown over a course of approximately 8 fences not to exceed 2’6”.

CLASS 16: \$1500 MEDIUM HUNTER DERBY

Horses/ponies will compete on a classic course of no less than 12 fences. Course height is 2’6: with options set at 2’9”. Proper show attire required - Shadbelly encouraged. See judging criteria.

CLASS 17: HIGH HUNTER DERBY WARM UP O/F

Open to all horses & ponies. To be shown over a course of approximately 8 fences that range from 2’9” to 3’.

CLASS 18: \$2000 HIGH HUNTER DERBY

Horses/ponies will compete on a classic course of no less than 12 fences. Course height is 3’ with higher options of up to 3’. Proper attire required - Shadbelly encouraged. See judging criteria.

HUNTER DERBY JUDGING CRITERIA

Horse/pony will receive one bonus point for every high option jumped without major faults in both rounds. Each round will have numeric scores and bonus points announced separately. Round 1 and 2 scores will be combined to determine final placing. In the case of ties in the overall placing, the handy round scores (round 2) will be used to break any ties. Derbies are open to horses or ponies, any age riders, and professional or non-professional riders.

ROUND 1 – HUNTER CLASSIC COURSE

To be shown over a hunter classic course with jumps reminiscent of the hunt field. To be judged on performance, hunter pace and style, quality and substance, movement and brilliance.

ROUND 2 – HANDY HUNTER COURSE

Course will include a minimum of one “handy option”. To be judged on style, brilliance and handiness.

RULES & EXTRAS

- Entries are open through day of show with no post-entry penalty.
- There will be no schooling on the Derby Field.
- Management reserves the right to split, cancel or combine classes.
- Formal Hunting, Cubbing, or Horse Show Attire is suitable with ASTM helmet required.
- Classes 9-18 are planned to be ridden on the grass Derby Field if suitable grounds conditions prevail. Otherwise classes will be run in the Grand Prix Ring.
- One horse and/or one rider may enter more than one Derby
- Please bring water for your horse(s).
- NO dumping manure in fields please.
- Pay close attention to all parking signs and directions for trailer or car parking.
- Dogs must be on a leash.
- The Ridge at Riverview, the horse show management, and Amwell Valley Hounds will not be responsible for any accident to any rider, horse, spectator or equipment which may occur during the preparation or conduct of this horse show.
- Reserve your Tailgate spot! \$100 for a ringside parking place. Contact [Sue](#) or [Liz](#)!

Shall be awarded to the horse or pony ridden by Junior (under 18 years), with the highest points in classes 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6.

The Family Farm Challenge Perpetual Trophy - Donated by Mrs. Sharon Roberto.
Shall be awarded to the AVH Member with the highest points in classes 9, 11, 12, 13, 14.

Hunt Team Champion Perpetual Trophy - Donated by Dr. Robert A. Silver
Shall be awarded to the winning Hunt Team in Class 14.

Ladies Hunter - Edge of the Woods Farm Perpetual Trophy, donated by Gordon Smith, MFH and Dr. Kennette Sohmer, shall be awarded to the leading lady rider over fences in Classes 9, 10, 12, 15, 16, 17, 18

Wendy Hopper Award - Crystal Perpetual Trophy. In memory of Wendy Hopper, long time AVH Subscriber. Awarded to the Derby rider who demonstrates the great horsemanship and style epitomized by the late Wendy Hopper. Winner to be selected by the Masters of Amwell Valley Hounds.
